

Frequently Asked Questions about Silverfort and Azure Marketplace

What is the Microsoft Azure Marketplace?

It is a cloud-based online marketplace that provides access to a wide range of software applications, services, and solutions for deployment on the Microsoft Azure cloud platform.

What are the benefits of purchasing Silverfort via the Azure Marketplace?

- Accelerate the purchasing process by leveraging your existing Microsoft contracts, procurement, and payment vehicles. Use your organization's Microsoft Azure Consumption Commitment (MACC) to purchase Silverfort through the Marketplace
- Take advantage of your company's negotiated Microsoft spend benefits (i.e. Azure credits, etc.).

What is MACC?

The Microsoft Azure Consumption Commitment (MACC) is a contractual commitment that your organization has made to Microsoft to spend over a defined period of time. MACC enables the dynamic procurement of Azure without having to make a large upfront payment. Each month Microsoft will calculate qualifying spend and subtract this from your organization's overall commitment.

In addition to retiring your commitment by acquiring Microsoft services, MACC can be retired by buying Microsoft partner services like Silverfort through the Azure Marketplace.

Do I need to have MACC to buy through the Azure Marketplace?

No, Silverfort can be purchased via the Azure Marketplace with or without a MACC. Purchasing Silverfort through the Azure Marketplace allows for a streamlined procurement process, allowing you to leverage your existing procurement relationship with Microsoft.

How to know if my company has MACC?

Sign in to the Azure portal. Search for Cost Management + Billing. On the billing scopes page, select the billing account for which you want to track the commitment. If you see the option to select Azure benefit eligible only as a filter option, you have a qualifying Azure consumption commitment.
